This is the fourth in a set of periodic email messages to discuss the CycleArlington.com website changes.

There have been a number of organizational changes and content extensions lately. You may have noticed these when you use the website.

The **Home** page has changed slightly.

The News section has gotten longer allowing for longer text to be provided each week. This section is updated most Monday mornings to include news for the next 8 days. The weather report has been moved to be after the calendar which allowed more space for news. The service used to report weather has been changed which resolved an issue, as the previous weather reporting service did not work well in the chrome browser. The twitter feed was removed and is now available via a single click which reduced some of the time it was taking for the web page to load.

Look for the photos on the home page to change soon as we've moved past our major events and into riding season.

The **Rides & Events** page has been expanded to include additional sections for Invitationals, Out of Town Rides, Rides Advertised, and Starting Locations.

The **Our Bike Club** page has been expanded to include additional sections for Posting Rides, Resolving Email Issues, and more. There is a Ride Reviews section which we hope will expand as riders do various weekend Invitational and other longer organized rides.

The **Photos** content continues to grow as members provide photos of our rides.

The **Links** section has been broadened to include a variety of **Cycling** related content including pointers to various lists of rides in nearby states and advocacy groups supported by the club.

The **News** section was removed and the content distributed in more meaningful sections of the website. This change makes the website render better on phones and other devices with smaller screens.
