The swap is held at Centennial Park, 1209 Burr Oak Drive, Arlington Heights, IL. Centennial Park is located adjacent to Riley School.

The Arlington Heights Bike Swap allows everyone to sell or purchase bicycles and bicycle related items. The Arlington Heights Bicycle Club runs the event like a garage sale. Sellers set their own prices. The swap is ideal for anyone who has out grown their bicycle; has bicycles they no longer use; or want to upgrade their bicycle. In past years, bicycles of all sizes and vintage have been available --- from child sizes to adult sizes and aging from decades old to brand new.

Items are accepted for sale between 7:30AM and 12 Noon. Purchases can be made between 9:00AM and 4:00PM. Fees are 10% of any sold items. Any items which do not sell are returned to the owner without a fee and must be picked up by 5:00PM.

Bikes and equipment must be in good condition before being accepted for sale. There is a \$10 minimum for all items. All transaction are cash only; no checks, credit cards, or debit cards accepted. Sellers and buyers must be 18 years of age unless accompanied by an adult.
